

CANOPY INSTRUCTIONS

Sight Preparations- Choose a clear area that is level and has no obstructions or sharp objects (bushes, stakes, stones, etc.) and has a minimum 12 foot overhead clearance. Minimum clear area for canopy is:
20' x 20' Minimum of 30' x 30'
20' x 30' Minimum of 30' x 40'

Set-Up Instructions

1. Stretch Canopy top out on ground centered in the set-up area. Pull corner to corner until it is fully unfolded and the corners are square (fig. 1). (Be sure that the ropes extend from the attaching hole and over the side flap (fig. 2). If ropes are under the side flap (fig. 3) canopy top is upside down... turn over and begin again.
2. Extend ropes straight out from canopy (fig. 4).
3. Assemble side poles [2 piece] (fig. 5) and center pole(s) [3 piece] (fig. 6).
4. Lay side poles straight out from pole holes and drive a stake 1' from end of pole [with bend pointing away from canopy] (fig. 7). Caution... beware of buried wires and irrigation pipes. Attach ropes loosely to stakes.
5. Insert side poles into side holes and raise sides leaving poles at a 45% angle slanting inward at the bottom (fig. 8).
6. Insert Center poles carefully in Center holes and raise canopy top with center pole(s) to full upright position and tie off center pole ropes to center pole.
7. Raise side poles to full upright position and tighten side pole ropes as necessary (work your way around canopy several times tightening and adjusting) until edges are tight and straight.

Take Down

Wait until canopy is dry if possible (if not possible, please inform us so we can dry it properly to avoid mildew and stains). Fold canopy and store in bag. Disassemble poles and stakes and return in bags. Please double count to make sure that all pieces have been gathered up for return. If anything has been damaged, please do not hesitate to tell us... Damage Waiver covers accidental damages!

Emergency Procedures

In the event of a storm, if time allows lower center poles then side poles to drop tent top. Unhook ropes from stakes and wrap canopy top into a tight bundle and move it to an area sheltered from wind (you may leave poles and stakes in place for re-setup). If time does not allow take down, leave tent and seek a permanent structure for shelter. **DO NOT USE CANOPY AS A SHELTER DURING A STORM.**

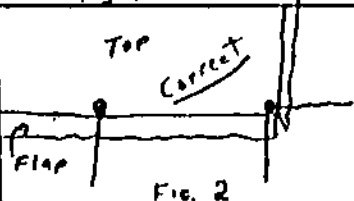

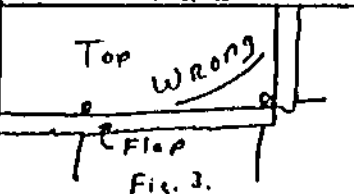

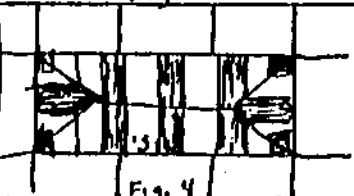

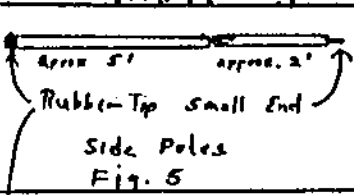

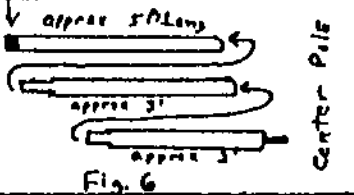

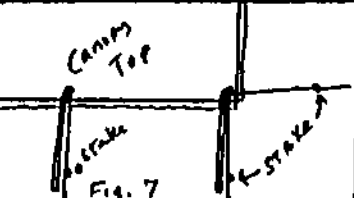

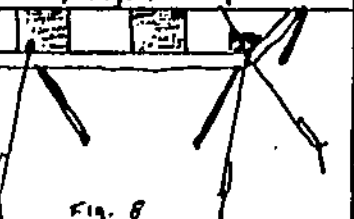
